Gujarat, Ahmedabad – July 25, 2024: Entrepreneurship Development Institute of India (EDII), Ahmedabad, is organizing the 'Mega Culmination of 100 Entrepreneurship Awareness Programmes (EAPs)' on July 25, 2024 at its campus. This event marks the concluding ceremony of 100 EAPs organised across 35 states and UTs, for potential women

entrepreneurs. The project was undertaken with the support and collaboration of National Commission for Women (NCW). The project was launched on June 2, 2023 in Ujjain.
