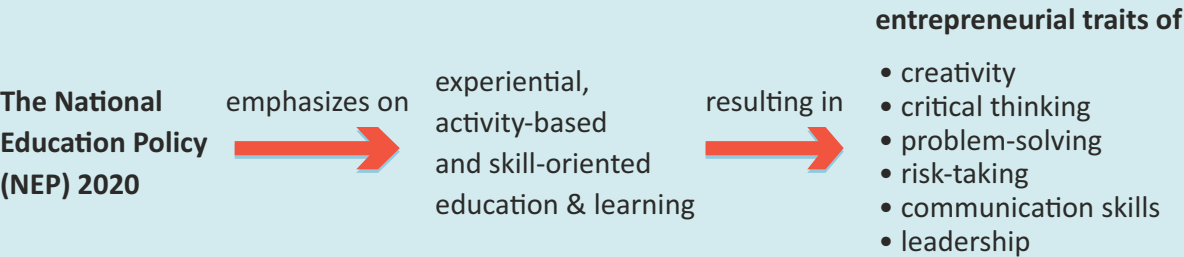

OBJECTIVE :

The objective of the camp is to inculcate the 'Spirit of Enterprise and Achievement' in children so that they target higher – order achievements.

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE CAMP :

- 12 to 16-year-old children are eligible. The number of participants is limited to 90. Adequate arrangements are made for girls, such as appointment of a lady caretaker.
- Since focus is on activities, there is no language bar. However, participants are expected to communicate in either English, Hindi, or Gujarati.
- Activities include mental gyms, motivation and creativity exercises, puzzles, value education, presentations, learning through success stories, industry visits, and 'yoga'.
- The entire group will be divided into two sub-groups of 12 to 14 (Group – A) years and 14 to 16 (Group – B) years.
- A parents' meet will be organized to brief them on their ward's performance and potential.
- Formal and informal interaction with well-known entrepreneurs and achievers from various fields will be organized to motivate the children to target mega successes in life.

VENUE :

The camp will be organized at the award-winning EDII Campus, Ahmedabad. Well-equipped, AC classrooms with modern amenities will be made available. Participants would be accommodated in AC rooms on a twin-sharing basis.

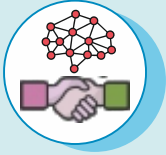

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About the Institute...

Launched in 1983, EDII is a National Resource Institute in entrepreneurship education, research, training, capacity building, institution-building, MSME growth and startup incubation. The Institute has been set up with the support of premier financial institutions, viz; the IDBI Bank Ltd; ICICI Ltd; IFCI Ltd; State Bank of India and with the backing of the Government of Gujarat. EDII stands on the belief that 'Entrepreneurs are not just born but can also be created by training and well-conceived interventions'.

The Institute was set up during times when there were more disbelievers than believers in entrepreneurship. Since then, it has evolved, curating successful training models, most of which are being replicated widely. The Institute successfully established the credibility of entrepreneurship as a development tool and went on to get recognized as the CENTRE OF EXCELLENCE by the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, Govt. of India.

EDII began by conceptualising Entrepreneurship Development Programmes (EDPs), and by launching a tested training model for New Enterprise Creation, implemented even today, as EDII-EDP model. Today EDII works in a collaborative mode with noted corporates as well as Government Ministries / Departments in implementing mega projects with resounding results in terms of New Enterprise Creation and generation of livelihood options. Additionally, the Institute's association with Institutes of national importance and premier organizations of the country, and other regulatory bodies is also generating commendable results in terms of deep-rooting entrepreneurship across sectors.
